Graduation Requirements

Different schools have different requirements for graduation. This often depends on the laws in the state in which they reside and the priorities of the school itself. To receive a US diploma from us, a student needs to complete the 21 credits. If students have taken courses at another school before joining us, it must be from a school that is accredited within the country it is in. When we receive a list of subjects (courses) taken, we will turn them into credits and every student will receive their personal suggested list of subjects to attend in Junior and Senior Year

If credits are being transferred from other schools, at least 6 must be completed with us in order for us to issue a diploma to the student.
